Highlights of FMCA's Governing Board Mtg 7/7/21

Norma Preston represented the Romers at the FMCA Board Meeting in July.

FMCA renewal dues will be \$50/family and commercial memberships and \$60 for first year members until 2025. Executive



Board quorum is 60% of the voting members.

The Investment Policy Objectives are to achieve a moderate growth for 5 years of 7% or better. Since the investment account is a taxable account, tax sensitivity should be a consideration in the management of the portfolio and selection of investment managers. Any decision to sell a security should take into consideration the investment merits of the decision and the tax ramifications. Managers will issue quarterly reports.

The average age of FMCA members is 72, with over twothirds of the membership 65 or older. With a vote of 118 for and 80 against, issues regarding recruitment and retention were postponed to the New Executive Board.

Membership Services Committee actions included: continuing Your Best Address and American Mailbox; Mobile App provider: Togo RV; <u>BigBattery.com</u> has rates for batteries and accessories; to include Membership Club pins for only 10, 20, 50, 100 & 200 members recruited and give a \$100 certificate for FMCA merchandise or towards dues or convention registration; adopt a Memorial Brick program for the FMCA Campground at \$50 per brick; keep Proteng Fire Protection benefits pending negotiations.

FMCAssist is now provided by Chubb. Put their phone number 877-352-0785 into the ICE (In Case of Emergency) section of your cell phone along with your FMCA member number. Chubb applies if you are 75 miles from home (your driver's license address) and need

MONACO ROMERS General Business Meeting San Dimas (Bonelli Bluffs) October 16, 2021

The meeting was called to order by President Duncan Holt at 9:30 a.m. Rob Wilson led the members in the Pledge of Allegiance.

New Members

Treasurer Report

G'Nell De Lack was unable to attend. Duncan reported that the balance in checking is \$10,233 & savings is \$5055 for a total of \$15,288.

Secretary Report

The minutes of the meeting on January 10, 2020 were posted on our website. Motion was made to approve the minutes and seconded. All in favor.

Rally Director Report

January 2022: The FMCA Indio rally was canceled. In its place a rally will be held on January 16-20 at Emerald Desert RV Resort in Palm Desert. The rally will be hosted by Paul & Pat Klempner, Jim & Susan Lewis, Dick & Shirley Burr and Juan Marquez & Debbie Holt. There are 3 open spots, flyers were distributed.

March 2022: March 27-31 Voyager RV Park, Tucson, Az. Rally begins the day after the FMCA rally ends. Rally Masters are Dick & Maureen Bouma and Joe & Leah Dingman, and John & Dottie Van Doren. Voting was held by present members. Romers - formerly known as Monaco Romers got 3 yes votes. A second vote was held for Monaco Romers & Friends, 3 opposed, the rest voted yes. No decision was made regarding changing our name at this meeting.

A motion was made, seconded and passed to amend By-law 3.e.ii as follows:

Balloting by mail *or electronic means* may be undertaken when a proposed matter is voted to be of such importance or urgency that a total membership vote is advisable.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
